SUBJECT: Communist Party Line in Sudan Accuses US of Supporting Fascism in Egypt

**MSY-11-18, Admin, Communists, Egypt**

The Communists in the Sudan are spreading the charge that the United States Government is supporting Gamal Abdel Nasser and his Government in Egypt and without this American support the RCC would collapse. This attitude, the party line continues, is typical of American policy, which is to support dictatorships and reaction. Unfortunately, the Communists are achieving some success with this malicious distortion because the majority of Sudanese support Neguib rather than Nasser and they are prepared to believe almost anything against Nasser. Furthermore, the Umma Party has recently agreed to cooperate with the Communists, (They say, "We would cooperate with the devil to defeat the Egyptians"), and the Umma Party organs have given some credence to this Communist propaganda.
