RECORDED AND TRANSCRIBED WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE
THIS CONVERSATION WAS REPORTED TO THE PRESIDENT ON FEBRUARY 12. IT FULLY RECOGNIZE
THE ENORMOUS EFFORT HIS MAJESTY AND YOU
ARE MAKING TO OVERCOME POLITICAL FORCES THAT ARE
ANTAGONICAL TO THE OBJECTIVES WE ARE JOINTLY SEEKING. AS
WE BOTH KNOW, THERE IS MUCH AT STAKE IN THE MEETING WHICH
IS CONVENING IN ALGIERS, AND I WANT TO DO ALL I CAN TO
ENSURE THAT IT IS ENTIRELY SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME. YOU MAY BE
INTERESTED IN MY FOLLOWING STATEMENT AT THE TIME THE BOYCOTT IS
IN EFFECT. WE HAVE RECEIVED PUBLIC AND PRIVATE
MESSAGES FROM PRESIDENT NIXON THAT KING FAISAL HAS
MADE A JUST AND LASTING COMMITMENT TO WORK TOWARD THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST.
THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS 242 AND 338, AND QUOTE,
"THE SECURITY COUNCIL REAFFIRMS ITS SUPPORT FOR THE
PRESIDENT'S POSITION AND THE POSITION OF THE
PEOPLES OF THE AREA, AND CALLS UPON THEM TO
DETERMINE COLLECTIVELY THE MEASURES NECESSARY
TO SECURE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
PRESIDENT'S POSITION AND THE POSITION OF THE
PEOPLES OF THE AREA."
