SUBJECT: Situation in Jordan

The situation in Jordan remains tense as of noon today. The following details are available:

Earlier in the day, Baghdad Radio had announced that regular Iraqi troops had moved into positions alongside Fedayeen units. Lt. General Ammash, the Iraqi Vice President, arrived in Jordan today, flying into Mafraq, a major military base used by Iraqi forces. Meanwhile, a Lebanese newspaper has reported that Iran has been reinforcing its military forces along the Iraqi border. According to a clandestine report, shortly before the outbreak of the current crisis, King Hussein had received assurances from the Shah of Iran that he would engage in a certain amount of saber rattling on the Iraqi border in the event the Iraqis attempted to interfere in Jordan.

2. Following an emergency meeting of the Cabinet, Jordan today rejected an Iraqi demand that King Hussein order the Army to stop firing against the Fedayeen. The Jordanian rejection insisted that the firing was initiated by the Fedayeen and the Government counter-fire had stopped before the Iraqi note was received. Reports were circulating in Amman and Beirut that King Hussein is considering declaring martial law and has asked for the resignation of the Government and intends to replace it with a military regime.
