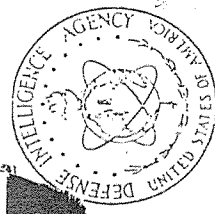
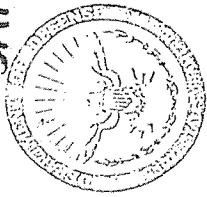

Current Situation

Despite patrolling by joint fedayeen-Jordanian police units in Amman, a five minute exchange of machine-gun fire occurred between unidentified units in the northern district of that city.

been determined whether this alert is related to increased tensions in Amman, or is in preparation for possible fedayeen-fomented dissidence in Lebanon.

Al Fatah claims that it conducted its own investigation of the rape of two American women in Jordan. According to an al Fatah spokesman, two men were apprehended, tried, and executed for the crimes. The al Fatah claim has not yet been verified.

According to the State Department 37 key personnel remain in Jordan in an official status at the US Embassy. All US Embassy dependents have been evacuated.

The some 2,500-man Saudi force in Jordan consists of a reinforced infantry brigade located in southwest Jordan. The projected move of these elements to Jordan will not significantly improve poor Saudi capabilities.
